The project will give social work students from BiH and Germany the opportunity to do research on the topic of social inclusion in the respective countries and at the same time work together with the civil society and learn how to produce podcasts to share information with a wider public. Through the active involvement of Radio F.R.E.I the students will not only learn from a social work perspective but get a much wider perspective on the role of civil society. During the exchange participants will learn about active citizenship, the importance of independent media and citizen journalism.

Working language is English. Participants must take part in both workshops.
