### Applying to study at the University of Applied Sciences Erfurt (Fachhochschule Erfurt)

In order to start or continue a degree course at the University of Applied Sciences Erfurt, please post us your application for prospective international students and enclose certified copies of the **following documents**:

- your school leaving certificate
- proof of studies so far or your degree certificate if you have already studied in your home country
- a list of subjects and grades from your degree course if you have already studied in your home country
- proof of your German language skills (at least level B1) at the time of application. In order to commence your studies, you must provide proof that you have passed TELC C1 Hochschule, DSH 2 or TDN 4 in the case of TestDaF.

*Ukrainian documents must be submitted in both the native language and the German translation.*

If you do not have your school certificates, university transcripts/certificates or proof of language proficiency, please submit with your application a curriculum vitae and a written statement on your previous education and the whereabouts of your certificates. In this case, it would be necessary for you to attend a "Studienkolleg" (prep college for incoming international students).
