

**Regulations of the Student Council at the Department of Conservation and Restoration
University of Applied Sciences Erfurt**

Preamble

The student council represents the interests of the student council in the field of conservation and restoration vis-à-vis the university management and other institutions and organizations. It represents the interests of students in the field regardless of their political and religious stance, as well as their national affiliation.

The Student Council is not involved in party politics. However, it can work with parties and other organizations if it serves the protection of student interests and does not violate principles of order.

§ 1

On the basis of the statutes of the student body of the Erfurt University of Applied Sciences, the student body of the conservation and restoration department decides on the following rules.

§ 2 The Student Council

- (1) All students enrolled at the FH Erfurt in the field of conservation and restoration form the student council.
- (2) All students in the field have the right to participate in student self-administration.

§ 3 The body of the student council

The body of the student council is the student council. This is to be chosen by the department of conservation and restoration. The electoral regulations of the Student Union FHE regulate further details.

§ 4 Tasks of the Student Council (FSR)


- (1) The interests of the student council are represented by the student council.
- (2) The Student Council has the following tasks, regardless of the responsibility of the university and the student union:
 1. The student council decides on the organization of the student council in the field of conservation and restoration.
 2. He works closely with the student representatives of the subject council, the student council and others Departments of the FHE together.
 3. He is involved in matters relevant to the news and works together with internal commissions.
 4. Technical, social and cultural interests of the student council are represented.
 5. He informs the students of the subject about the politics of the FH Erfurt.

§ 5 Choice and composition of the FSR


- (1) The student council consists of 3 to 4 members. All students according to § 2 paragraph 1 have the active and passive right to vote.
- (2) The election is made directly and simultaneously with the other bodies of the University of Applied Sciences Erfurt. The FSR's term of office is 12 months.
- (3) All members of the FSR have equal rights and coordinate tasks to be undertaken among themselves.
- (4) The FSR has a quorum if at least half of its members are present. All decisions of the FSR are made with a simple majority.
- (5) The FSR meets regularly and announces its decisions and projects in the specialty by means of notices. Each session is open to all students in the field.
- (6) A 2/3 majority of the elected members is required for the resolution of the rules and a change to them, within the framework of § 1.
- (7) If the FSR decides to resign by 2/3 majority of its members or if it is voted out by vote in the subject area (general assembly according to §9 Paragraph 3 of the statute of the student body of the FHE), new elections must be scheduled within 30 days. At least 20% of students in the field of conservation and restoration must vote and confirm the deselection with a simple majority. The old FSR will remain in office until this point.


